- Bachelor's degree or higher from an accredited college or university, completing 120 semester hours or quarter-hour equivalents of college credit. This includes specific requirements for accounting and business courses as follows:
 - Complete 21 semester hours or quarter-hour equivalents of upper level accounting courses from a board-recognized college or university.
 - Complete 24 semester hours or quarter-hour equivalents of upper level related business courses.
 - Within the coursework, complete 2 semester hours of accounting or business communications.
- Successful passing of the Uniform CPA Examination, which consists of three four-hour sections and one four-hour Discipline section (chosen by the candidate). The core sections are Auditing and Attestation, Financial Accounting and Reporting, and Taxation and Regulation. The Discipline sections are Business Analysis and Reporting, Information Systems and Control, and Tax Compliance and Planning.
- To be licensed in Texas, one must pass an examination on the State Board of Accountancy's *Rules of Professional Conduct*, (the *Rules*) as required by *Section 901.252* of the *Public Accountancy Act*. A passing score is a score of 85% or higher.
- One-year qualifying full-time non-routine accounting work experience under direct supervision of licensed CPA.
- Complete the electronic fingerprint process for a background check of the criminal history files of the Texas Department of Public Safety and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
